Pittsburgh Parking Authority Expands Ticket-by-Mail Program Across More City Zones

Pittsburgh, PA — January 8, 2026 — The Pittsburgh Parking Authority (PPA) is pleased to announce the continued expansion of its **Ticket-by-Mail** program into additional enforcement zones throughout the city. This rollout follows the successful model currently used for street-cleaning violations, helping improve efficiency while reducing the number of paper tickets placed directly on vehicle windshields.

As more zones transition to this system, residents will notice a decrease in printed tickets left on vehicles, as most violations will now be recorded electronically and mailed to the registered vehicle owner.

What Pittsburgh Residents Can Expect

- **Mailed Notices:** In designated Ticket-by-Mail zones, tickets will be mailed directly to the registered owner of the vehicle.
- **Same Enforcement, Different Delivery:** Parking Enforcement Officers retain full authority to issue manual tickets and place them on windshields when necessary, though this will occur less frequently in areas utilizing Ticket-by-Mail.
- **Sample Ticket Provided:** An example of what the mailed violation looks like is included with this release to familiarize residents with the new format.
- **How to Contest a Ticket:** Also listed on the attachment are step-by-step instructions outlining how to contest a ticket through Parking Court.
- **Camera-Enforced Lots:** Certain parking facilities are monitored through camera-based enforcement, which operates 24 hours a day, seven days a week, with the exception of Sundays from 12:00 a.m. to 11:59 p.m. Posted signage is in place in specific lots where camera enforcement applies.
